EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF COMMUNION NOTES

In The Narthex

- 1. Attire Dress appropriately when assigned to serve.
- 2. You should be in a State of Grace with no mortal sins.
- 3. Use the sign-in book in the narthex so that the sacristan knows if there are enough Eucharistic Ministers.

During Mass

- 1. Go to the altar immediately after the Sign of Peace.
- 2. Bow before stepping on red carpet (sanctuary).
- 3. Folded your hands at chest level so that you are a model for altar servers.
- 4. 2 EM on each side of altar
- 5. Remember to wash your hands using waterless antibacterial soap that's on the tables to the left and to the right of the altar.
- 6. Remain at a distance until Father begins to give Communion to servers.
- 7. Bow before receiving Body of Christ and before receiving Blood of Christ.
- 8. Distribution of Body of Christ:
 - a. In front of the altar
 - b. For choir <u>first</u> and for elderly at back of church second unless the person is along the aisle and standing.
 - c. Giving Communion on the tongue
 - d. Do **not** distribute Communion to people in narthex unless requested by the priest.
- 9. Distribution of Blood of Christ
 - a. If right-handed, take the chalice in your left hand.
 - b. Rotate purificator so that you're not wiping from the same spot.

10. End of Communion

- a. Consumption of the remaining Precious Blood should take place after returning into the sanctuary.
- b. At the conclusion of distributing Communion, you should <u>not</u> bow as you pass in front of the altar because you are already carrying the Precious Body or Blood of Christ.
- c. Return ciborium and chalice to Father
 - i. Wait for him to take it. Do not place anything on the altar.
- d. Eucharistic Ministers bow together before returning to your pew.

Other Topics

- 1. Intinction is not permitted under ordinary circumstances.
- 2. At the tabernacle
 - a. Push key in quickly and use your other hand to open the door.
 - b. Genuflect when you open the tabernacle before you remove the ciborium.
 - c. Genuflect before closing the tabernacle door.
- 3. One of the Eucharistic Ministers should get the reserve ciborium upon entering the sanctuary.
- 4. Help wash vessels after Mass.
- 5. If a Eucharistic Minister is missing, look around to make certain that the assigned person is not on his/her way to the altar. If not, feel free to take that person's place.
